1. Constitution of Anishinaabe Circle British Columbia Society

Anishinaabe Circle British Columbia (ACBC) aims to support connection and community for Anishnaabeg (Ojibwe Peoples) living in British Columbia through language learning (Anishnaabemowin), Elder teachings, ceremonies, cultural, plants-based, and arts activities.

The purpose(s) of this Society is (are):

- (1) To provide a culturally-directed space for and by Anishnaabeg to maintain their connection to culture and language away from the home territories;
 - (2) To elevate the presence and heritage of the Anishnaabeg in BC society for all's benefit;
 - (3) To offer accessible, inclusive programming and build community for the Anishnaabeg diaspora in BC.
- We honour Anishinaabe language, traditions and knowledge, and we recognize and respect the communities on whose territories we run our programs on.
